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Sewer System Design Standards

I. PURPOSE

- To provide standard requirements, rules and design criteria for all sewer systems to be connected to the county system.

II. SCOPE

- These standards are intended to serve as a guide in the design and preparation of sewer system plans and specifications of sewer systems to be connected to the county system. Adherence to the requirements listed will provide a high level standard of system performance in accordance with state and federal mandated water quality standards.

III. DESIGN STANDARDS

- All sewers, pumping stations, retention facilities, and all other sewer system appurtenances shall meet the following design standards:
 1. Recommended Standards for Wastewater Facilities (10 States Standards) 1997 edition of a report of the Wastewater Committee of the Great Lakes - Upper Mississippi River (Web site www.hes.org)
 2. Detroit Water and Sewerage Department (DWSD). Suburban Division II, Design, Detailing and Construction Standards for Sanitary Sewers connecting to the Detroit Regional System.
 3. Wastewater Disposal Standards and Regulations for the County of Oakland.
 4. The provisions of the Michigan Public Acts of 1994, as amended, MCLA 324.4101 et.seq.
 5. The Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner; Standards and Specifications including the provisions of the WRC work instruction for Sanitary/Combined Sewer Plan Review (SS-0806)
 6. CVT Design Standards, as determined by local CVT.
 7. WRC Operation and Maintenance Design for all systems operated and maintained by the WRC including Standard Detail Sheets, Sewer Plan Review Checklist, and Pump Station Design Standards [work in progress].
