

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
SPECIAL ASSESSMENT AND RIGHT TO APPEAL
BUSH LAKE SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that John P. McCulloch, Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner, for and on behalf of the Bush Lake Special Assessment District approved by the Circuit Court for Oakland County on July 14, 2006, will hold a public hearing at the Village of Holly Council Chambers, located at 315 S. Broad Street, Holly, MI 48442 at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 19, 2010. The purpose of the Hearing is to review and hear objections to the special assessment roll and amounts for the construction of a new control structure for Bush Lake, located in Section 27 of the Township of Holly and the Village of Holly, County of Oakland, State of Michigan.

The total amount of the special assessment is \$267,000.00. The duration of the special assessment is ten years. The first installment will be levied on the 2010 winter taxes for properties located within the Bush Lake Level Special Assessment District. Any person affected by this special assessment may appear and be heard at the Hearing. The Special Assessment Roll will be on file at Holly Township and the Village of Holly Offices and the Office of the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner for public examination.

Appearance and protest of the special assessment at the time and place of review is required in order to appeal the amount of the special assessment to a court of competent jurisdiction. An owner of or party of interest in property to be assessed, or his or her agent may appear in person to protest the special assessment, or may protest the special assessment by letter filed with the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner, One Public Works Drive, Waterford, MI 48328, at or prior to the time of the review, in which case personal appearance is not required. If the special assessment is protested as provided above, the owner or any party having an interest in the real property may file a written appeal of the special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal within 30 days after the confirmation of the Special Assessment Roll has been published in a newspaper of general circulation.
