  - ◆ Final print size will be 5 x 7, landscape format
  - ◆ Medium: drawing, painting, computer-generated

      - File not to exceed 8 MB
      - 300 dpi or greater
  - ◆ Please do not mount, frame, fold or roll artwork

  - ◆ One entry per student
  - ◆ Artwork becomes the property of the WRC Office. It cannot be returned.
  - ◆ Original artwork only, no previously published entries, please
  - ◆ Consent to reproduce artwork for publicity purposes is assumed
