## Starting or Growing a Veteran-Owned Business?

Sign up for a Boots to Business Reboot, an entrepreneurship training program for veterans and their spouses, sponsored by the Small Business Administration (SBA)

Oakland County's One Stop Shop Business Center is proud to host a Boots to Business Reboot event for veterans and spouses of veterans.

Boots to Business is an entrepreneurial education and training program offered by the SBA as part of the U.S. Department of Defense Transition Assistance Program (TAP). The course provides an overview of entrepreneurship and applicable business ownership fundamentals. Active duty service members (including National Guard and Reserve), veterans of all eras and spouses are eligible to participate.

After completing the *Introduction to Entrepreneurship* course, participants can elect to further their study through the B2B Revenue Readiness online course, delivered through a partnership with Mississippi State University. This course is offered at no cost to service members, veterans and their spouses.
