

COVID-19: Resources for Employers



Oakland County Michigan Works! is supporting employers throughout the region during the COVID-19 response. We offer a number of resources to you, as your organization makes operational decisions during this time. Consider these services:

MICHIGAN WORK SHARE PROGRAM

Rather than lay off employees, this program allows you to keep your skilled workers with reduced hours, while they collect partial unemployment benefits to make up a portion of their lost wages. Go to Michigan.Gov/Workshare

OAKLAND COUNTY MICHIGAN WORKS! LAYOFF SUPPORT

If you do have to lay off employees, our rapid response teams can work with you to provide them with information on unemployment insurance, outplacement and retraining assistance, Trade Adjustment Assistance and other services. Go to OaklandCountyMIWorks.com

UNEMPLOYMENT CLAIMS

Employees who are laid off DO NOT have to visit an Oakland County Michigan Works! service center to file an unemployment claim at this time. They should go online at Michigan.gov/UIA or call (866) 500-0017 and follow the instructions. After doing this, they DO NOT have to visit one of our offices to register for work.
