TO: Oakland/Troy Airport Users

RE: Runway 9/27 Resurfacing & Updated Sign Boxes

Oakland/Troy Airport is preparing for the resurfacing of Runway 9/27 and an update of the runway/taxiway signage boxes in our ongoing effort to maintain the safety and integrity of the airport. **This single-phase project has a 20-day construction period with a planned start date of September 20, 2021 at 0600L. Completion is anticipated October 11, 2021 (weather permitting). The Airport will be CLOSED for aircraft operations during this entire construction period.**

Important details during construction:

- For your safety, aircraft will not be authorized to taxi during the construction period.
- Access to the T-hangar or tie-down areas by car **will not be restricted**. You will have landside access to your T-hangar.
- This project does not include the aprons in front of the T-hangars or tie-downs.
- Helicopter operations may proceed with caution until further notice.
- T-hangar tenants may relocate their aircraft to Oakland County International Airport (PTK) for a tie-down at no charge on a first come, first serve basis. Be advised PTK is also under construction of its primary runway through mid-October.

Limited space is available for relocation; however we will do our best to accommodate your needs. You may contact Michelle Stover, at 248-666-5980 or via e-mail at ocia@oakgov.com, to assist you with your relocation request. **Once construction begins there will be no opportunity for relocating.**
