

How to Participate Remotely in Oakland County Board of Commissioners Meetings

Due to the recent COVID-19 outbreak, the Oakland County Board of Commissioners (BOC) is following social distancing and crowd size recommendations, as mandated by the State of Michigan. The BOC encourages members of the public to access and participate in upcoming meetings (both committee and full BOC meetings) through the options listed below.

Address the BOC during the public comment portion of the agenda

Address the Board via an online public comment submission form

[Use this form \(https://forms.oakgov.com/143\)](https://forms.oakgov.com/143) to submit public comment for BOC meetings. All respondents must identify themselves by name, pursuant to BOC rules. Any responses that do not adhere to this will not be read at the public meeting.

OR

Address the Board via audio/phone call

Members of the public can submit public comment via audio/phone. Please note that the audio conference and phone lines will open half an hour prior to the start of the meeting.

Follow the instructions below:

1. Join via audio/phone call
 - To submit public comment via phone, call 1-872-240-3311 and use the access code 271-151-061
2. Once you join, announce your name and the community where you reside. You will be called upon to speak in succession.
3. If you are not speaking, please mute your device.
4. When you are speaking, please mute or pause the meeting if you are watching it live on YouTube.
5. Do not speak over other speakers. Each person has three (3) minutes to speak, and the BOC staff will give a 30 second warning if necessary.
