**COUNTY OF OAKLAND**

**OAKLAND COUNTY ZOOLOGICAL AUTHORITY RENEWAL MILLAGE**

The Oakland County Zoological Authority was established pursuant to Public Act 49 of 2008 and formed to allow for continuing zoological services for the students, residents and visitors of Oakland County. The law allows the Authority to seek authorization from the electors to levy a tax on real and personal property to provide revenue to an accredited zoological institution for this purpose. Accordingly, as a renewal of the previously approved millage authorization which expires with the 2017 tax levy, to continue providing zoological services to benefit the residents of the County, shall the 0.1 mill (10 cents per \$1,000 of taxable value) on all of the taxable property located within the County continue to be imposed for a period of ten (10) years, being years 2018 through 2027? It is estimated that if approved and levied, this millage would generate approximately \$5,609,562 in 2018.

Shall this proposal be adopted?

**CITY OF AUBURN HILLS**

**HEADLEE OVERRIDE MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Increasing residential population, business expansion, tourism and job growth in the City have created significant growing demands on the Fire Department. The original 2.5 mills designated for fire services (Fire and Life Support activities) in the City Charter would be sufficient to expand services with additional staff and equipment. However, the 1978 Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 rolled that millage back to 1.7604 mills. The City is requesting to restore the millage rate back to the original voter-authorized 2.5 mills as provided for in the City Charter. The current 1.7604 mills generates annual revenue of about \$2.6 million. An override to 2.5 mills will produce an additional amount of revenue of about \$1,070,000, for a total estimated annual revenue amount of \$3,637,092. If approved by the voters, a property with a taxable value of \$59,300, which is the average property taxable value in Auburn Hills, will pay about an additional \$43.86 per year in property taxes to adequately fund the Fire Department.

Shall a "Headlee Override" be adopted so that the current limitation on the amount of City taxes that may be levied for fire purposes against all taxable property in the City of Auburn Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, be increased as follows:

Up to 2.5 mills from approximately 1.7604 mills (\$2.50 from approximately \$1.7604 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for fire purposes.

If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated maximum amount of \$3,637,092 for fire purposes for the City in 2017, by allowing the City to levy the maximum mills for fire purposes previously approved by the voters and authorized by the City Charter and the State law which have been reduced as required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

**CITY OF HAZEL PARK**

**SHOULD THE CITY OF WAYNE BECOME A PARTICIPATING MEMBER IN THE  
SOUTH MACOMB OAKLAND REGIONAL SERVICES AUTHORITY (SMORSA)**

Shall the Authority, presently comprising the Cities of Eastpointe and Hazel Park, also include the City of Wayne, and levy up to 14 mills on the taxable value of applicable real and personal property located within the limits of the Authority for the remainder of the 20-year term, 2016 through 2034 inclusive, and should the vote not pass by a majority then the Authority's district will continue to include only the corporate boundaries of the Cities of Eastpointe and Hazel Park? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage would raise an estimated amount of \$6,046,684.00 in the City of Eastpointe, an estimated amount of \$2,373,756.00 in the City of Hazel Park, and an estimated amount of \$4,914,158.00 in the City of Wayne, for emergency services in the first year.

Shall the City of Novi, Michigan, be authorized to levy a new additional millage on taxable property within the City, not to exceed the annual rate of 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 10 years, commencing in 2017, for the purpose of funding capital improvements and capital projects, including, but not limited to, parks and facilities, land acquisition, pathways, and apparatus (such as fire trucks, heavy equipment). These funds shall not be used for operations or payroll. The estimated amount of revenue that will be collected by the City in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied is \$3,284,805.

## **CITY OF PONTIAC**

### **MILLAGE PROPOSITION TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS**

Shall the City of Pontiac continue to levy against the property in the City of Pontiac, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, .500 mill(s) (\$0.50 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of ten (10) years, from 2017 to 2026, inclusive for the purpose of providing funds for planning, coordinating, evaluating, providing, and maintaining services to person 60 years of age and older, including but not limited to maintenance of the senior centers. A portion of the millage will be dispensed to the Tax Increment Financing Authority. It is estimated that \$330,000.00 will be collected in the first year that the millage is renewed. If approved, this would be a renewal of a previously authorized millage expiring in 2016.

Should this proposition be approved?

### **LIBRARY RENEWAL MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Pontiac be authorized to levy a renewal of the previously voted increase in tax limitation, which last resulted in a levy of 1.0 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), in an amount not to exceed 1.0 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the City of Pontiac for a period of ten (10) years, 2017 to 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of operating, maintaining and equipping the Pontiac Public Library and for all other library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the City will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the City in the 2017 calendar year is approximately \$669,000. A portion of the revenue may be required to be distributed to the City of Pontiac Tax Increment Financing Authority and Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.

Proposed Charter Revision #1

"The Charter currently provides that candidates for the office of City Council are nominated by submitting petitions signed by at least 25 and not more than 50 registered electors of the district and candidates for the office of Mayor are nominated by submitting petitions with at least 50 and not more than 100 signatures. Shall the Charter be amended to increase the number of signatures required for nomination to at least 50 and not more than 100 for City Council and to at least 250 and not more than 400 for Mayor?"

Proposed Charter Revision #2

The Charter currently provides that City property taxes for each fiscal year are due each July 1 and subject to additional charge on August 1st and on the first day of each month thereafter during which the taxes remain unpaid. Shall the Charter be amended to provide that property taxes are due each July 31 and subject to additional charge beginning on the first business day of September and on the first business day of each month during which the taxes remain unpaid?

**CITY OF ROYAL OAK**

**PROPOSAL A**

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 8, SECTION 11(B) OF THE ROYAL OAK CITY CHARTER TO ALLOW FOR A RENEWAL REFUSE COLLECTION, DISPOSAL AND CURBSIDE RECYCLING MILLAGE.

The proposed amendment to the Royal Oak charter, if approved, would allow the city to renew a millage levy for a period not to exceed five years (5), up to 1.00 mill, to defray the costs of refuse collection, disposal and curbside recycling.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

**CITY OF ROYAL OAK CHARTER AMENDMENT  
PROPOSAL B: REQUIREMENTS FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE**

Chapter Three, Section 3, and Chapter Four, Section 4 prevents anyone under 25 years of age who has not been a resident of Royal Oak for two years and a freeholder in the city (owner of real estate) from seeking city elective office. Neither the freeholder requirement nor the two-year residency requirements are legally enforceable due to court decisions. The proposed amendment would delete the freeholder requirement and allow registered voters who will have been residents of the City for at least one year preceding the election to run for elective city office.

Shall the proposal be adopted?

**CITY OF WIXOM**

**LIBRARY RENEWAL MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Wixom be authorized to levy a renewal of the previously voted increase in tax limitation, which last resulted in a levy of 1.08 mills (\$1.08 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), in an amount not to exceed 1.08 mills (\$1.08 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the City of Wixom for a period of ten (10) years, 2017 to 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of operating, maintaining and equipping the Wixom Public Library and for all other library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the City will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the City in the 2017 calendar year is approximately \$700,000. A portion of the revenue may be required to be distributed to the City of Wixom Downtown Development Authority and the Oakland County Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.

**TOWNSHIP OF ADDISON**

**16-1 Fire Department Capital Improvements**

Shall the previous voted millage increase in the Tax limitations (imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution) totaling .75 mill, (.75 per \$1,000.00 taxable value) reduced to .7320 mill as required with millage rollbacks and which the millage expires December 31, 2016 be renewed and increased back to .75 mill (.75 per \$1,000.00 taxable value) for levy in the years 2017 through 2024 for a period of eight (8) years, for Fire Department Capital Improvements within the Township? This funding is for the purpose of providing Capital Improvements to the Fire Department of Addison Township, and is the only millage funding for Capital Improvements for the Fire Department. Shall Addison Township, based on the 2016 taxable value, levy up to .75 mills with the first year estimated revenue for Fire Department Capital Improvements being two hundred forty six thousand, five hundred and seventy four (\$246,574) dollars?

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BLOOMFIELD**

**Renewal of Public Safety Millage**

Shall the Charter Township of Bloomfield be authorized to renew up to 1.9935 mills for a period of ten years to finance continued fire, police and public safety protection, commencing with the December 2017 levy? Approval of this proposal would permit a tax of \$1.9935 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township. This proposed millage is a renewal of previously authorized millage which expires in 2016. This millage will be subject to applicable constitutional tax limitation provisions at the time of levy, and will not exceed the above-stated rate. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$6,706,547 in the first year if approved and levied.

**Renewal of Road Maintenance Millage**

Shall the Charter Township of Bloomfield be authorized to renew up to .7115 mills for a period of ten years to finance continued road maintenance, commencing with the December 2017 levy? Approval of this proposal would permit a tax of \$0.7115 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township. This proposed millage is a renewal of previously authorized millage which expires in 2016. This millage will be subject to applicable constitutional tax limitation provisions at the time of levy, and will not exceed the above-stated rate. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$2,393,633 in the first year if approved and levied.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF COMMERCE**

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF COMMERCE MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL FOR LIBRARY SERVICES**

Shall the expired previously voted increase of .7 Mills per \$1000 of taxable property value (reduced by required millage rollbacks to .6895 mills per \$1000 of taxable property value for year 2015) above the non-voted tax levy limitation of 5 mills imposed by Section 27 of Public Act 359 of 1947, be renewed to authorize the levy 0.6895 of one mill, being \$0.6895 cents per \$1000 of taxable property value, for a period of six years for the provision of public library services? The proposed renewal rate of 0.6895 of one mill or \$0.6895 cents per \$1000 of taxable property value may be further reduced by year 2016 required millage rollbacks. The taxable property value may be further reduced by year 2016 required millage rollbacks. The estimated revenue that will be collected in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied is \$1,245,311.58, a portion of which will be distributed to the Commerce Township Downtown Development Authority as required by Public Act 197 of 1975.

## **CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HIGHLAND**

### **RENEWAL OF MILLAGE FOR MEDICAL AND FIRE SERVICES**

Shall the Charter Township of Highland, Oakland County, Michigan be authorized to renew and levy on all taxable property within the Township for a period of six (6) years (2017 thru 2022 inclusive) for the purpose of providing medical and fire services in the Township 1.4295 mills on each dollar (\$1.4295 per \$1,000.00) of taxable value as finally equalized pursuant to 33PA 1951, as amended?

The estimated revenue to be collected in the first year the millage is authorized and levied is \$1,022,323.37. A small portion of the revenue collected, estimated to be approximately \$13,200, will be required to be distributed to the Highland Downtown Development Authority.

The proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage that has been reduced to 1.4295 as required by Article IX, Section 31, of the Constitution of the State of Michigan and does not constitute new additional millage.

## **TOWNSHIP OF HOLLY**

### **Renewal of One (1) Mill For The Support and Maintenance Of The Holly Township Public Library**

Shall the previously vote in the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all real and personal property in the Township of Holly, Oakland County, Michigan which resulted in a levy of 1.000 mill (\$1.00 per \$1000 taxable value) and reduced to .9783 (\$.9783 per \$1000 taxable value) as a result of Headlee Amendment millage reductions, be renewed and restored back to one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1000 taxable value) for a period of 5 years beginning in 2017, for all library purposes permitted by law for the support and maintenance of a free public library in Holly Township, Oakland Township, Oakland County, Michigan; and shall the Township levy such a millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$274,191.00. To the extent required by law, a small portion of the revenues from this millage (1.28%) will be captured by and dispersed to the Village of Holly Downtown Development Authority.

### **Renewal of One Half (.5) Mill for support and Maintenance of Holly Township Parks**

Shall the previously voted increase in the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all real and personal property in the Township of Holly, Oakland County, Michigan; which resulted in a levy of .4950mill (\$0.4786 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in 2010, be renewed and increased back to .5 mill (\$0.50 per one thousand dollars of taxable value) for a period of 5 years, starting in 2017, for the purpose of acquiring, developing, operating, and maintaining of parks and recreation areas in Holly Township, Oakland County, Michigan; and shall the Township levy such renewal in millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$132,695.22. The revenue from this millage shall be disbursed to Holly Township.

## **CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF INDEPENDENCE**

### **RENEWAL OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES OPERATING MILLAGE**

Shall the Charter Township of Independence be authorized to continue the previously authorized levy of up to 3.5653 mills for a period of four (4) years, starting with the December 2016 levy, for purposes of funding fire protection and emergency services, including advanced life support, in the Township?

This proposed millage is a renewal of previously authorized millage approved by the voters in 2012 for the above-stated purposes. Approval of this proposal would renew a tax limitation increase of \$3.57 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township (rounded up for estimating purposes). It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$5,197,621.00 in the first year if approved and levied. It is estimated that 99.74% of the annual millage revenue would be disbursed to the Charter Township of Independence for fire and emergency services and, as required by law, 0.26% would be disbursed to the Township's Sashabaw Road Corridor Improvement Authority. The amount disbursed to the Sashabaw Road Corridor Improvement Authority shall be collected solely from properties located in the Sashabaw Road Corridor Improvement Authority District.

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**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF LYON**

**POLICE SERVICES DEDICATED MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Shall the Charter Township of Lyon, Oakland County, Michigan, renew the current levies due to expire in August 2016 of 2.1212 and 0.6361 mills, as reduced by the required roll backs, which combined total 2.7573 (less any reduction pursuant to MCL 211.34d), with a renewal levy of 2.7573 mills (\$2.7573 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of eight years, 2016-2023, inclusive, for the general operation of police services, raising an estimated \$2,531,233.00 in the first year the millage is levied, of which a portion will be disbursed to the Charter Township of Lyon Downtown Development Authority pursuant to State law?

**LIBRARY BOND PROPOSITION**

Shall the Charter Township of Lyon, Oakland County, Michigan, borrow a sum of money not to exceed Eight Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping public library facilities and acquiring and improving the site thereof? The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of refunding, is 30 years; the estimated millage that will be levied to pay the proposed bonds in the first year that the levy is authorized is .5535 mills (which is equal to \$.5535 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property in the Charter Township of Lyon); and the estimated simple average annual millage that will be required to retire the bonds is .5535 mills.

**LIBRARY REPLACEMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the Charter Township of Lyon replace the current levy of 0.5280 mills due to expire in 2017 with a new levy of 1.585 mills (\$1.585 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of twenty years, 2016-2035, inclusive, for the purposes of operation, maintenance, support, supplies and equipment and for all other library purposes authorized by law, raising an estimated \$1,449,633.01 in the first year the millage is levied, of which a portion will be disbursed to the Charter Township of Lyon Downtown Development Authority pursuant to State law?

Police Services Millage Replacement

Shall the Charter Township of Milford, Oakland County, Michigan, replace the current levies of 3.0395 and 0.7994 mills, which combined total 3.8389, due to expire in 2017, with a new levy of 3.8250 (\$3.825 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of fifteen years, 2017-2031, inclusive, and subject to authorized disbursements mandated by law, for the purposes of the general operation of police services, estimated to provide revenue of \$3,216,986.77 in the year 2017?

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF OAKLAND**

**PROPOSED PARKS AND RECREATION MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the Charter Township of Oakland be authorized to renew the current levy of 0.7307 of one mill for a period of ten (10) years beginning with the December 2017 levy for the purpose of providing funds to be used for the support of the Oakland Township Parks and Recreation Commission for acquisition, maintenance, operation, improvement and management of Township parks, recreation areas, facilities, programs, recreation, and services. Approval of this proposal would renew the tax limitation levy of 0.7307 mills on all taxable property in the Township. Approval of this proposal would authorize the levy of approximately \$0.7307 per \$1,000 of taxable property in the Township. It is estimated that this proposal would result in the authorization to collect up to \$945,418.01 in the first year if approved and levied.

**PROPOSED LANGUAGE FOR OLDER PERSONS COMMISSION  
TRANSPORTATION MILLAGE RENEWAL**

Shall the Charter Township of Oakland renew and continue to levy 0.0876 mills (\$0.0876 per \$1,000) to provide funds to the Older Persons Commission to enable it to maintain or increase handicapped and senior transportation services, on the taxable value of all property assessed for taxes in the Township for ten (10) years, beginning with the December 2016 levy, which will provide an estimated revenue of \$109,169.31 if levied in full in the first year of such levy?

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ORION**

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ORION FIRE MILLAGE**

Shall the Charter Township of Orion be authorized to levy up to 1.984 mills for a period of 4 years beginning December 2016 and expiring December 2019 to provide for the following purposes: fire protection services for the operation and maintenance of the Orion Township Fire Department, including the purchase of equipment and buildings to serve the Charter Township of Orion and the Village of Lake Orion, and the hiring of personnel and payment of wages and benefits. Approval of this proposal would authorize the levy of approximately \$1.984 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township and the Village of Lake Orion, a portion of which will be disbursed to the Village of Lake Orion Downtown Development Authority. It is estimated that this proposal would result in authorization to collect approximately \$2,810,671.15 in the first year if approved and levied. A property with taxable value of \$50,000 would be taxed \$99.20 for the millage.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF ORION POLICE MILLAGE**

Shall the Charter Township of Orion be authorized to levy up to 2.9885 mills for a period of 4 years beginning December 2016 through and including December 2019 to provide police protection services; including, the purchase of equipment, operating costs, officer quarters and personnel costs in the Township? Approval of this proposal would authorize a levy up to \$2.9885 per \$1,000 of taxable value on all taxable property in the Township and the Village of Lake Orion, a portion of which may be disbursed to the Village of Lake Orion Downtown Development Authority and by contract the Village of Lake Orion. It is estimated that this proposal would result in authorization to collect approximately \$4,506,993.87 in the first year if approved and levied. A property with a taxable value of \$50,000 would be taxed \$149.43 for the millage.

**TOWNSHIP OF ROSE**

**Rose Township Proposal #1**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Rose Township of 1.3585 mills (\$1.36 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to 1.3549 (approximately \$1.35 per \$1000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at 1.3549 mills and levied for six (6) years, 2016 through 2021 inclusive, to provide fire department services including, but not limited to, emergency medical response and ambulance transport, raising an estimated \$330,040 in the first year the millage is levied of which a portion will be disbursed to the North Oakland County Fire Authority?

If adopted, Rose Township Proposal #1 would renew the expired 1.3549 mills levied in 2015 to be used only for fire department operations and services including, but not limited to, fire suppression and prevention, advanced life support emergency medical response and ambulance transport (approximately \$1.35 for each \$1,000 of taxable value).

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**Rose Township Proposal #2**

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Rose Township of .75 mills (\$.75 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to .7480 (\$0.7480 per \$1000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at 0.7480 mills (\$0.7480 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for six (6) years, 2016 through 2021 inclusive, to provide fire department services including but not limited to, fire suppression and prevention, emergency medical response and ambulance transport, raising an estimated \$182,209 in the first year the millage is levied of which a portion will be disbursed to the North Oakland County Fire Authority?

If adopted, Rose Township Proposal #2 would renew the expired \$.7480 mills levied in 2015 (approximately 75 cents for every \$1,000 of taxable value) on the taxable value of property in Rose Township for the sole purpose of continuing to fund all fire department operations and services including, but not limited to, advanced life support emergency medical response and ambulance transport.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD**

**POLICE MILLAGE RENEWAL QUESTION**

Shall the two previously voted increases in the collective amount of 1.4789 mills (\$1.4789 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the constitutional limitation on the amount of taxes upon all taxable property within Springfield Charter Township, which collectively, with required millage rollbacks, last resulted in a levy of 1.4663 mills, be renewed at 1.4663 mills (\$1.4663 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for a period of ten (10) years, from 2016 to 2025, inclusive, for the purpose of maintaining the current level of police services, including personnel, equipment, facilities, and operational costs? If approved, the Township shall collect from this levy in the first year approximately \$605,000.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT ADDITIONAL MILLAGE QUESTION**

Shall the limitation on general ad valorem taxes imposed upon taxable property within Springfield Charter Township be increased by 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), and that amount levied for a period of ten (10) years from 2016 to 2025, inclusive, for the purpose of providing additional fire protection services and emergency services, including personnel, equipment, facilities, and operational costs? If approved, the Township shall collect from this levy in the first year approximately \$605,000.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WATERFORD**

**RENEWAL OF POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATING EXPENSE MILLAGE #2**

Shall the Charter Township of Waterford be authorized to renew and levy the previous voted millage of 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property) for a period of 10 years from 2016 to 2025, for the continued staffing, maintenance, and operation of the Township Police Department? If the millage is renewed and levied, the estimated revenue that will be collected in the first year from the levy in December 2016 will be \$ 2,973,248.20.

**RENEWAL OF FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATING EXPENSE MILLAGE #1**

Shall the Charter Township of Waterford be authorized to renew and levy the previous voted millage of 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property) for a period of 10 years from 2016 to 2025, for the continued staffing, maintenance, and operation of the Township Fire Department? If the millage is renewed and levied, the estimated revenue that will be collected in the first year from the levy in December 2016 will be \$ 1,982,165.47.

**RENEWAL OF FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATING EXPENSE MILLAGE #2**

Shall the Charter Township of Waterford be authorized to renew and levy the previous voted millage of 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property) for a period of 10 years from 2016 to 2025, for the continued staffing, maintenance, and operation of the Township Fire Department? If the millage is renewed and levied, the estimated revenue that will be collected in the first year from the levy in December 2016 will be \$ 1,982,165.47.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WEST BLOOMFIELD**

**WEST BLOOMFIELD PARKS AND RECREATION**  
**RENEWAL OF EXISTING PARKS AND RECREATION MILLAGE**

Shall the Charter Township of West Bloomfield be authorized to continue to levy up to [.3892] of one mil for a period of ten (10) years (2018-2027, inclusive) for the purpose of providing funds for the acquisition, preservation, enhancement, and maintenance of land for parks and recreational purposes? Approval of this proposal would result in the renewal of a previous approval and would authorize a levy of up to [38.92] cents per \$1,000 of taxable value for all taxable property in West Bloomfield Township. It is estimated that approval of this proposal would result in the authorization to collect \$1,231,000 in the first year of levy.

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF WHITE LAKE**

**LIBRARY BOND PROPOSITION**

Shall the Charter Township of White Lake, Oakland County, Michigan, borrow a sum of money not to exceed Eight Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,600,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping public library facilities and acquiring and improving the site thereof? The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of refunding, is 20 years; the estimated millage that will be levied to pay the proposed bonds in the first year that the levy is authorized is 0.4431 mills (which is equal to \$0.4431 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property in the Charter Township of White Lake); and the estimated simple average annual millage that will be required to retire the bonds is 0.5764 mills.

**AVONDALE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

**REPLACEMENT AND RESTORATION OF NON-HOMESTEAD OPERATING MILLAGE**

*This proposal would authorize Avondale Public Schools to continue to levy up to 18.00 mills for general school district operating purposes only on non-homestead property (business, commercial, rental and seasonal homes) in the School District. Principal residences are exempt from this millage. This authorization would (i) replace an authorization previously approved by voters which expires with the School District's 2017 tax levy; (ii) restore the authority to levy mills previously authorized which has been reduced by 0.0432 mill by application of the Headlee Amendment; and (iii) increase the prior authority by two mills. This authority would allow the School District to levy only that portion of the mills against non-homestead property required for the School District to receive revenues at the full foundation allowance permitted by the State in the event of future Headlee rollbacks.*

Shall the limitation on the amount of tax upon taxable property in the Avondale School District, Oakland County, Michigan be increased by 20.00 mills (\$20.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for ten (10) years, the years 2016 to 2025, inclusive, to provide funds for operating expenses of the District? If approved, this millage would raise an estimated \$7,000,724 for the District in 2016.

**REPLACEMENT SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

*Of the 1.00 mill requested, 0.5993 mill constitutes a continuation of authority which would have expired with the 2017 levy, as reduced by operation of the Headlee amendment, and 0.4007 mill constitutes new additional millage which would restore authorization reduced by operation of the Headlee amendment.*

Shall the Avondale School District, Oakland County, Michigan, be authorized to levy 1.00 mill to create a sinking fund for the purpose of the construction or repair of school buildings and the improvement and development of sites and for any other purpose which may be authorized by law for the use of sinking fund proceeds, by increasing the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the School District for a period of ten (10) years, being the years 2016 to 2025, inclusive? It is estimated that 1.00 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) would raise approximately \$905,472 in 2016.

BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Clarkston Community Schools, Oakland County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Seventy-Five Million Nine Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$75,980,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings, in part for secure entrances; remodeling, equipping and re-equipping and furnishing and re-furnishing school buildings; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; erecting an outdoor storage building at Clarkston High School; and preparing, developing, improving, and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities, and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2017, under current law, is 0 mill (\$0.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 2.09 mills (\$2.09 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district expects to borrow from the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program to pay debt service on these bonds. The estimated total principal amount of that borrowing is \$25,515,796 and the estimated total interest to be paid thereon is \$29,394,271. The estimated duration of the millage levy associated with that borrowing is 19 years and the estimated computed millage rate for such levy is 7.00 mills. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

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The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$121,060,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is approximately \$4,289,535.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)

## **FERNDALE PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

### **SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the Ferndale Public Schools, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to levy 1.30 mills (\$1.30 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) to create a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings, the improvement and development of sites and any other purpose permitted by law, by increasing the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the School District for a period of fifteen (15) years, being the years 2016 to 2030, inclusive? It is estimated that 1.30 mills (\$1.30 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) would raise approximately \$843,000 in the first year that it is levied.

*(Under state law, sinking fund proceeds **may not** be used to pay teacher or administrator salaries.)*

## **GOODRICH AREA SCHOOLS**

### **OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Goodrich Area Schools' existing authority to levy operating millage expired with the 2015 levy. This proposal will correct a technical error in the operating millage renewal proposition approved by the voters on March 8, 2016 and will allow the school district to continue to levy that millage in 2016 only in an amount not to exceed 18 mills on all property in the School District (except principal residence and other property exempted by law). The millage is required for the school district to receive its full foundation allowance per pupil.

Shall the millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Goodrich Area Schools, Genesee, Oakland and Lapeer Counties, Michigan, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) (as a renewal of previously approved millage authorization which expired with the 2015 levy) for 2016 only to allow for the continued levy of millage to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2016 is approximately \$1,107,788?

*(This is a renewal of the operating millage that expired with the 2015 tax levy and does not constitute new additional millage.)*

## **LAKE ORION COMMUNITY SCHOOLS**

### **LAKE ORION COMMUNITY SCHOOLS COUNTY OF OAKLAND STATE OF MICHIGAN**

### **BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX PROPOSAL**

This proposal, if approved by the electors, will allow the Lake Orion Community Schools to levy a building and site sinking fund tax, the proceeds of which will be used to make improvements and repairs to the School District's facilities. Pursuant to State Law, the expenditure of the building and site sinking fund tax proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for teacher, administrator or employee salaries, maintenance or other operating expenses.

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Shall the Lake Orion Community Schools be authorized to levy two (2.0) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a period of ten (10) years, from [July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2026], to create a building and site sinking fund to be used for the construction or repair of school buildings or any other purpose authorized under Michigan law? This millage would provide estimated revenues to the Lake Orion Community Schools of approximately [Three Million Three Hundred Ninety Thousand (\$3,390,000) Dollars during the 2016 calendar year], if approved and levied.

## **MADISON DISTRICT PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

### OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance. The remaining .9791 mill is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Madison District Public Schools, Oakland County, Michigan, be renewed by 18.9791 mills (\$18.9791 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2017 to 2021, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2017 is approximately \$1,785,600 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2016 tax levy)?

## **SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF OAK PARK**

### SINKING FUND MILLAGE PROPOSAL

*The following proposal would continue the authority (first approved by the voters in 1997, extended in 2006, expiring in 2016) for the School District to levy a sinking fund millage. This proposal would also restore the prior authorization, which was rolled back through application of the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Constitution to 2.9592 mills, to 3.00 mills.*

Shall the School District of the City of Oak Park, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to levy 3.00 mills to create a sinking fund for the purpose of the construction or repair of school buildings and the purchase, improvement and development of sites and, to the extent permitted by law, the purchase of school buses, furnishings and equipment, including instructional technology equipment, by increasing the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on the taxable value of taxable property in the School District for a period of twenty (20) years, being the years 2017 to 2036, inclusive? It is estimated that 3.00 mills (\$3.00 mills per \$1,000 of taxable valuation) would raise approximately \$1,000,000 in the first year that it is levied.

*(Under state law, sinking fund proceeds **may not** be used to pay teacher or administrator salaries.)*

## **OXFORD COMMUNITY SCHOOLS**

### OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

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Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Oxford Community Schools, Oakland and Lapeer Counties, Michigan, be increased by 18.4442 mills (\$18.4442 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2017 to 2026, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes (17.9442 mills of the above is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2016 tax levy, .0558 mill is a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963, and .4442 mill is to restore millage lost as a result of potential future reductions that may be required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963, to be levied only to the extent necessary to restore such future reductions); the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and 18 mills are levied in 2017 is approximately \$5,345,514?

### **GENESEE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT**

#### **OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all taxable property in Genesee Intermediate School District be increased by .25 mills (\$.25 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) for twenty (20) years, calendar years 2016 to 2035, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for lifelong education, adult education, community education, training, and enrichment, and for other operating purposes, in Genesee Intermediate School District? It is estimated that the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2016 will be approximately \$2.3 million. Revenues will be disbursed to Genesee Intermediate School District.

### **MOTT COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

#### **MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSITION**

Shall the previous voted increase in the limitation on the amount of taxes that may be levied by Charles Stewart Mott Community College, Genesee County, Michigan, against all property in the community college district be renewed for a total of .6410 mill (which is equal to \$.6410 per \$1,000 of taxable value of real and tangible personal property), for a period of 10 years, 2018 to 2027, inclusive, to provide funds for community college purposes? If the .6410 mill increase is approved it is estimated that the college will collect approximately \$5.7 million of revenue in the first calendar year it is levied. The proposed millage is a renewal of a previously authorized millage.

### **FERNDALE AREA DISTRICT LIBRARY**

#### **Library Millage Proposal**

Shall the Ferndale Area District Library, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to levy a new additional millage in an amount not to exceed 3.50 mills (\$3.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable property within the Ferndale Area District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2017 to 2026, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library in the 2017 calendar year is approximately \$1,799,000. A portion of the revenue collected may be required to be distributed to the City of Ferndale Downtown Development Authority and the City of Ferndale Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.

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**HAZEL PARK DISTRICT LIBRARY**

**HAZEL PARK DISTRICT LIBRARY MILLAGE**

Shall the Hazel Park District Library, County of Oakland, Michigan, be authorized to levy a millage in an amount not to exceed 2.50 mills (\$2.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable value) against all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Hazel Park District Library district, for a period of ten (10) years, 2017 to 2027 inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library in 2017 calendar year is approximately \$423,885.00. A portion of the revenue collected will be required to be distributed to the City of Hazel Park Downtown Development Authority and the City of Hazel Park Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.
