

Michigan Court Rule 6.106

Michigan Court Rule 6.106 (A) through (I), As revised on June 1, 1992, *Pretrial Release*, requires state courts to set conditions of pretrial release or detention that address each defendant's potential for failure to appear and threat to public safety. At the same time, MCR 6.106 dictates that courts set for bail-eligible defendants the least restrictive form of release needed to ensure future court appearance and safeguard the public.
