

# Notice Regarding Pandemic Response

Due to the current public health concerns related to COVID-19, probation appointments will be conducted over the telephone for the foreseeable future. This includes first probation appointments, regular monthly probation appointments, Sobriety Court appointments and presentence investigation/screening and assessment evaluations. Please be ready to take a call from the probation officer in a quiet setting at the designated time. If you have paperwork to submit to your probation officer, please fax it prior to your appointment time to 248-620-6057. If you do not have access to a fax, you can mail via USPS or send as a PDF attachment via email to [522probation@oakgov.com](mailto:522probation@oakgov.com). Note, this is an incoming email address only.

The Courthouse remains operational, but is very limited on persons entering the building. Probation violation hearings will be held over Zoom, unless otherwise indicated. You will be notified of when and how to appear virtually for the violation. Note that a bench warrant can be being issued for failure to attend Zoom hearings.

Payments should be made on time. Payments can be made with a credit card online [here](#) or by check/money order via USPS mail to the courthouse.

If you are diagnosed with or suspected of having the coronavirus, please contact your probation officer as soon as possible.
