

Notice Regarding Pandemic Response

Due to ongoing public health concerns related to COVID-19, the probation department continues to provide most services via remote technology. If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19, been directed to quarantine, or are awaiting a test result for COVID-19, please contact your probation officer immediately.

Probation services are provided as described below.

Type of Appointment	Timeline	Reporting Type
Presentence investigations (PSI) and substance abuse evaluations (SAE)	After conviction, before sentence	Telephone
First probation appointment, including Sobriety Court	After sentence	In person at 52/2 District Court
Regular monthly probation and Sobriety Court appointments	After first probation appointment	In person or Telephone, as directed by the Probation Officer
Probation violation hearings	After sentence	In person at 52/2 District Court
Review hearings	After sentence	In person at 52/2 District Court

Telephone appointments:

Please be ready to take a call from the probation officer in a quiet setting at the designated time. If you have paperwork to submit to your probation officer,

please fax it prior to your appointment day to 248-620-6057. Alternately, you can send documents via USPS mail or as a PDF attachment to the probation officer's email.

Payments should be made on time. Payments can be made with a credit card online at <https://courts.oakgov.com/oaketix> , by check/money order via USPS mail or with cash in person at the courthouse.

In person appointments at 52/2 District Court:

All persons required to report for the first probation appointment must complete a security screening upon entering the building and comply with safety protocols for the duration of the visit.
