VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION

The new Michigan Repeat Offenders Law, which went into effect on October 1, 1999 for persons who have had more than one alcohol-related offense or more than two driving while license suspended offenses, orders mandatory vehicle immobilization. This Order is part of your sentence.

The agency that you contact will give you further instruction on what to do. **The immobilization device MUST be placed on the vehicle on the date stipulated on your Order; not before or not after. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN A SHOWCAUSE HEARING BEFORE THE JUDGE THAT YOUR CASE IS ASSIGNED TO, RESULTING IN POSSIBLE VEHICLE FORFEITURE AND/OR JAILTIME.**

Court personnel cannot suggest to you which agency to contact.
