





No-Cost Career Training to Qualified Candidates Medical Assistant Apprenticeship

Are you ready to launch a career in health care? There is a growing demand for certified medical assistants throughout southeast Michigan. Take a look at the challenging and rewarding apprenticeship program now being offered to a limited number of qualified people who want to pursue this profession.

Oakland County Michigan Works! Oak Park, in partnership with Henry Ford Health System, Oakland Community College and Henry Ford College, is hosting information sessions in April to share details about the Medical Assistant Apprenticeship program and answer your questions.

Medical assistant apprentices, under the direct supervision of a mentor, provide a variety of duties to help provide quality care to patients, including:

- ✓ Greeting and escorting patients to exam rooms
- ✓ Measuring and recording the height and weight of patients
- ✓ Demonstrating competency with computerized charting systems, such as EPIC

Upon completion of the apprenticeship, students will receive a USDOL certificate and a certificate of completion from either Oakland Community College or Henry Ford College. They will need to pass the national certification exam. Students selected for the apprenticeship program will be hired by Henry Ford Health System and remain with the organization if they successfully complete the program.

Applicant Requirements

- 18 years or older
- High school diploma or GED
- Official transcript of any post high school education
- Criminal background check
- Physically capable of performing essential functions of medical assistant apprentice with or without reasonable accommodation and without posing a direct threat to the health and safety of the individual or others
- Pass pre-employment health screening: nicotine, urine drug testing, MMR, Varicella and hepatitis B, flu injection, TB skin testing, respirator fit testing, and color vision testing


