Welcome and Introductions

- Meeting commenced at 2 PM and introductions were made.

General Discussion on SOS Pilot

- Debra Hendren reported that she provided an ID training on the pilot exception program to all participating communities.
- James Fackler reported that there were no updates regarding the SOS pilot program.
- Exceptions reported there has been no activity or requests.
- An agency reached out to the ID Taskforce asking for further advocacy regarding the rules about changing your gender on an ID.
 - Clarification was provided by SOS that in order to update your gender on a MI ID, the applicant should submit the current ID, a birth certificate or U.S. passport/passport card bearing the new gender, or a court order of gender designation. Because the state of Michigan has a process in place to change gender designation this practice is used.

Statewide Advocacy Efforts for ID

- The Drop Box is no longer being used to share documents. A website has been created that contains all documents, and Jason from MCAH will send out to the group.

Social Security Administration

- Currently agencies are using HMIS along with a shelter verification letter until we hear otherwise from Dan. This seems to be working with no major issues.
