Environmental Health

- Licenses and inspects food service establishments, investigates foodborne illness outbreaks and conducts food safety education classes.
- Issues permits for on-site sewage disposal systems and evaluates subdivisions and condominium developments.
- Indoor air information including Lead, Radon and Asbestos.
- Issues permits for on-site water systems, licenses public swimming pools and conducts water testing for drinking, swimming pools, and public beaches.
- Issues permits and conducts safety classes for body art practitioners and establishments.
- Investigates radiological contamination.

Tuberculosis Control

The Health Division provides Tuberculosis (TB) skin testing, treatment and counseling services. There is a \$3.00 charge for TB skin tests. Additionally, all clinic visits require a \$5.00 fee per visit, per client. Payment method is cash, credit and debit cards. Fees are not refundable.

TB skin tests are done in the general clinic on the following days:

Monday 12:00 - 8:00 p.m. Tuesday & Wednesday 8:30 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. Thursday - No Testing Friday 2:00 - 5:00 p.m.

Clients **must** return to have their test read no sooner than 48 hours and no later than 72 hours after the test is administered. No TB tests are given on Fridays before Monday holidays. Chest X-rays are done only by referral after talking with a nurse.
