As a condition of 52-3 District Court, you are required to abstain from alcohol use and to submit to testing. For the St. Patrick’s Day Holiday, **Judge Asadoorian is requiring you to test between the specified time(s) as listed below.**

You are required to bring **identification**, this **letter**, and your **payment**. Failure to comply with this will result in a violation. You may submit to testing at your current testing facility or your local police department. Please turn in all receipts.
