**Summary of SOP's for Facilities with High Potential for Pollutant Runoff**  
**March 2025**

**I. POLICY:**

This policy is meant to provide a summary of where to find the following as it relates to OCPRC's SWPPP, PIPP and SPCC plans in place for facilities with a high potential for pollutant runoff into stormwater structural controls with a discharge of stormwater to surface waters of the state:

- A. List of significant materials stored on site that could pollute stormwater, how they are stored and handled, and the potential for their discharge to stormwater
- B. The good housekeeping practices implemented at the site
- C. Description and schedule for conducting routine maintenance and inspections
- D. Description and schedule for conducting comprehensive inspections at least once every 3 months
