Welcome to Addison Oaks Campground

2026 Camping Season: May 1 - Oct. 14

Addison Oaks County Park & Campground is a 1,140-acre natural oasis with two lakes where visitors can recreate for the day, camp under the stars or explore the park's rich history. Among its amenities is a 20-mile trail system for hiking and biking, boat/kayak/bike rentals, a Solar System Trail, an 18-hole disc golf course, fishing, playgrounds and picnicking.

The campground features 180 campsites, five group camping areas, 2-, 4- or 6-person cabins and 6-person yurts.

All sites have water and 20/30/50 amp electrical service except sites 133-174, which have 20/30 amp.

Cabin and Yurt Amenities

Amenities include:

- 2-person cabin with one queen-sized bed
- 4-person cabins with two twin-sized bunk beds
- 6-person cabins and yurts with two twin-sized bunk beds, one queen-sized bed and air conditioning/heating unit
- Parking for two vehicles

All cabins and yurts are equipped with a small refrigerator, table and chairs, electricity, water nearby, outdoor grill, picnic table, fire pit and microwave.

- Guests must provide their own linens
- Except for service animals, no animals are allowed in (or to remain overnight outside of) cabins or yurts
- Smoking is not permitted inside cabins or yurts
- Gas/portable heaters are not allowed
- No tents are allowed at cabin or yurt sites
- Restrooms located nearby

A \$50 deposit is required at check-in. If no damage is done, the \$50 deposit will be returned at time of departure after inspection has been completed. Credit card preferred for deposit; cash is also accepted.

Tips for Happy Campers

General Reminders

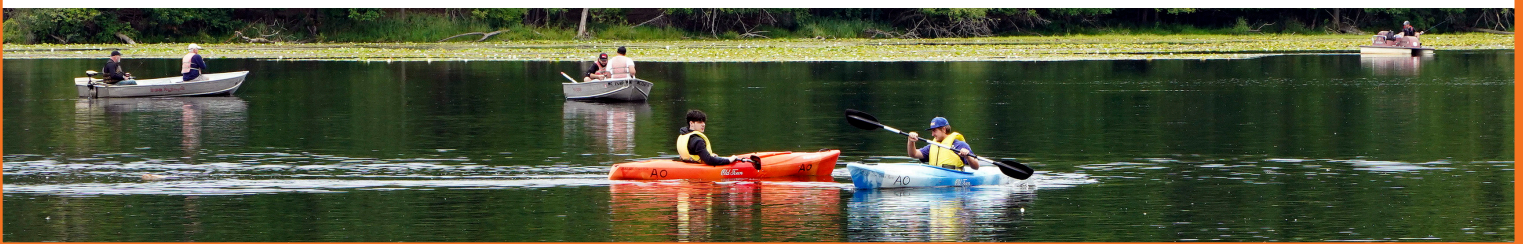
- Quiet hours are 11 p.m.-7 a.m.
- **Call the contact station (248-693-2432) with any issues, including noisy neighbors. If the contact station is closed, please call Oakland County Sheriff Dispatch directly (248-858-4950).**
- Visitors are welcome from 8 a.m.-10 p.m. No visitor entry after 9 p.m. Overnight vehicles are required to register at the contact station for a parking pass that allows after hours entry.
- Campsites are limited to immediate family or up to four unrelated persons ages 18 years and older. Maximum of two tents or one camper and one tent per site.
- When parking, the tongue of trailer hitch must face the road.
- Site fee includes two vehicles; only two vehicles allowed per site.
- Fire pits are for firewood only; do not put trash, pallets, brush or limbs into the fire pits. Portable firepits are not permitted.
- Help keep the park clean by placing all trash into the proper receptacles. Dumpsters are in Areas A and C, across from the shower buildings, and at the dump station. Recycling centers located near dumpsters in Areas A and C.
- All wastewater (gray/black) must be disposed of at the designated dump station(s) per the Oakland County Health Division Sanitary Code Article 3, Section 4.1.
- Portable waste tanks may only be connected to a camping unit while in the process of emptying on-board holding tanks campers must be present and in view of portable tanks during the emptying process. Portable showers and portable toilets are not permitted.
- No hose splitters are allowed to be attached to any water spigot or hose per the Oakland County Health Division.
- Golf carts are prohibited for use in campgrounds, including the campground roads and pathways.
- Please do not cut or damage trees.

Check-in and Check-out Information

- Check-in time for all campsites, cabins and yurts is 3 p.m. (early check-in based on availability-please call ahead).
- Check-in unavailable after 9 p.m. daily.
- Campsite check-out time is 1 p.m.
- Cabin and yurt check-out time is 1 p.m. - please notify contact station 30 minutes prior to leaving for inspection.

For Your Safety

- Do not feed birds or other wildlife at any time - this includes bird feeders attached to or around RVs and trailers.
- Cats and dogs are welcome, but must be kept inside or on a 6-foot leash - animals may not be left unattended and are not allowed at or in cabins or yurts, and owners or caretakers must pick up all dog droppings.
- Hammocks are permitted but may not be permanently attached to trees or campground fixtures.
- Clotheslines must be removed at sundown.

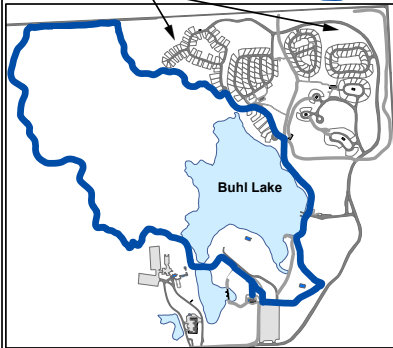
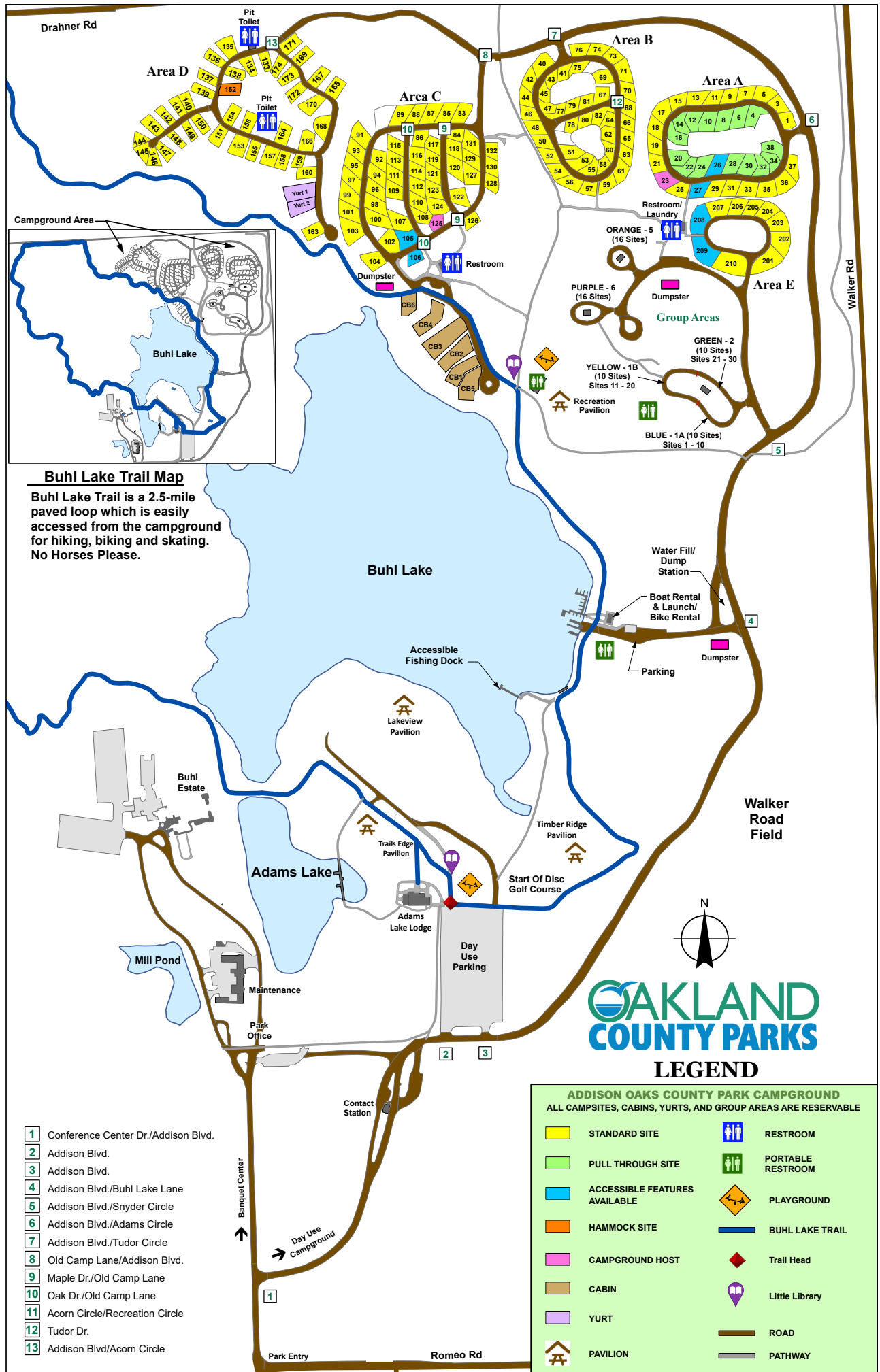
Contact Station hours during camping season:

Firewood

- Available for purchase at contact station
- Fire-starters \$2 each or \$3 for 2
- Colorful fire \$3

Ice - \$3/7 lb. bag at the contact station

Bait - \$4

Showers - Free for on-site campers

Camp Store - located at the Boathouse, open seasonally

Laundry/Change Machine

- Located in Area A shower building
- Open 8 a.m.-8 p.m. daily

Sanitary Services/Dump Station

- Free for on-site campers
- \$30 for non-registered campers

Honey Wagon - Mondays Only

- \$30 for all tanks (gray and black)
- Must sign up at contact station by 7 p.m. Sunday. Must be present when service is being performed. Service is provided by a contracted company. See contact station for holiday schedule changes.

Miscellaneous Tips

- The campground is mowed Mon-Wed, weather permitting. Please remove lawn decorations to prevent damage.
- Mail should not be sent to the campground. Please make arrangements with the post office.
- Park trail maps and information about local amenities are available at the contact station.

Addison Oaks Camping Fees

Cabins/Yurts:

- 2 or 4-Person Cabin \$87/night
- 6-Person Cabin \$120/night
- Yurts \$120/night
- Holidays/Special Events Additional \$5/night

Campsites: Electric & Water On-Site

- Pull Through \$43/night *\$38/night
- Standard \$38/night *\$33/night
- Holidays/Special Events Additional \$5/night

*Oakland County Resident rate, Sun.-Thurs.

Monthly Rates:

- 20% off daily rates
- Does not apply to holiday/special event fee
- Discount only applies to full month of consecutive camping on same site.
- Monthly fee must be paid at time of initial reservation/registration.

Cancellation policy for campsites, cabins and yurts:

\$10 Reservation Modification / Cancellation Fee. Fee applies to cancellation of an existing reservation, the modification of existing reservation dates, or the change of sites, cabins, and yurts under an existing reservation.

If notice of cancellation is received seven or more days prior to the beginning of the reservation, all charges will be refunded, minus the cancellation fee.

If less than seven (7) days before reservation, one half of the rental/camping fees are refunded, minus the cancellation fee.

There will be no refunds or modifications after 3:00 pm on the day the reservation starts.

Reservations

Addison Oaks and Groveland Oaks campgrounds accept reservations for campsites, cabins and yurts 180 days (approximately six months) in advance. Groups and facility reservations are accepted 335 days (approximately 11 months) in advance. **The campgrounds will open for the 2027 season on April 30, 2027.**

Things to do at Addison Oaks

BOAT AND BIKE RENTALS

Located at boathouse on Buhl Lake. Must be 18 years of age or older to rent. Driver's license required. Individuals under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

- Tentative open May 22–Labor Day, weather and staff permitting.
- Thursday-Sunday: 8 a.m.-8 p.m. (last rental at 7:30 p.m.).
- Extended holiday hours posted onsite.
- Weekends after Labor Day based on staff availability.

PEDAL BOATS: \$5/half hour

KAYAKS: \$5/half hour (1 or 2 seater)

ROW BOATS: \$10/use

MOUNTAIN BIKES: \$5/half hour *(Helmet included with rental and must be worn.)*

SPECIALTY BIKES: \$5/half hour *(Helmet recommended and included with rental.)*

ADDISON OAKS TRAIN: \$3/ride

Schedule and advance tickets are available at the boathouse where the train boards and departs. *(Available most Saturdays between Memorial Day Weekend - Labor Day Weekend.)*

DISC GOLF: Open year round. 18 hole course. Bring your own discs.

FISHING: Shore and dock fishing on Adams and Buhl lakes. Bait available for purchase during camping season.

PLAYGROUNDS: Located north of Day Use parking lot and near the Recreation Pavilion.

Park Entry

With approval of the 2024 millage request, there is no charge for Oakland County residents to enjoy Oakland County day-use parks and dog parks. There will continue to be fees for pay to play attractions such as campgrounds and Holly Oaks ORV Park.

Guests who are not Oakland County residents are asked to pay a \$12 daily entry fee or a \$50 annual fee to help maintain and improve the parks.

Overnight vehicles in the campgrounds, regardless of residency, are required to be registered at the contact station for an overnight parking pass (required for after-hours entry). There is a two-vehicle limit per campsite.
