1. Nominating Petitions Available to Candidates April 14
2. Last day for filing nominating petitions - 4 o'clock May 4
3. Last day for filing acceptance of nomination - 4 o'clock. May 4
4. Certification of Candidatesby May 7
5. Last day for withdrawal of Candidates May 7
6. Notice of Election (Ballots will be mailed). May 11
7. Day of Election* June 2
8. Canvassing of votes by June 10

Ballots must have the outer envelope signed by the voter and be returned in a timely manner to be officially counted. Returned by US Mail in the pre-addressed/postage prepaid ballot return envelope, by County interoffice mail or a secure ballot box located throughout the County campus. Ballots must be post marked or received/collected on or before the date of the election.

TO: All Members of the Oakland County Employees' Retirement System

SUBJECT: Official notice of last day for the filing of nominating petitions for the regular election of one employee member to the Oakland County Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board.

1. The last day for the filing of petitions for candidacy for employee member to the Oakland County Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board for the four (4) year term ending December 31, 2027 is 4:00 p.m. Monday, May 4, 2026
2. No candidate shall have his/her name printed on the official ballot nor be qualified to fill the office of Employee Commissioner unless such nominating petitions have been filed in accordance with the regulations, by the above time, and the signatures of not less than fifty (50) active full-time County employees.
3. Official nominating petitions may be secured from the Secretary of the Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board located in the Executive Office Building, Human Resources, on the 2nd floor. You may contact the Retirement Unit at (248) 858-5215 or retirement@oakgov.com (OFFICIAL PETITION FORMS MUST BE USED).
4. Section B of the Oakland County Employees' Retirement System Trustee Election Policy & Procedures provides that no more than one employee member on the Retirement Board shall be from any one County Department, therefore employees of the following departments or divisions will not be eligible for this election:
 - SHERIFF'S OFFICE
 - CLERK/REGISTER OF DEEDS
5. All other rules and regulations set forth in the Retirement System's Trustee Election Policy & Procedures shall be strictly enforced unless otherwise determined by the Retirement and Deferred Compensation Board, in its sole discretion.
