## Nature Education

### Field Trips

### StarLab

StarLab is a portable, inflatable planetarium that can be brought to your facility or setup in ours. It requires a quiet, clean indoor area (minimum 23' and 11' high) with electricity. StarLab presentations are 45 minutes in length and accommodate up to 30 people, first grade and up.
