# Winter Activities and Amenities by Park

# **GOLF COURSES**

Glen Oaks, Red Oaks, Springfield Oaks and White Lake Oaks golf courses are available to those with their own equipment when the gates are open. There are no warming or restroom facilities.

#### PARK ENTRY

-<u>Daily pass or Annual Vehicle Permit</u> required for the following locations. Unless otherwise noted, please purchase prior to arrival as permits are not always available at the park during winter months.

## ADDISON OAKS

- -NEW! Winter Fat Tire Biking on 5.6 miles of trails
- -Buhl Lake Trail (2.5 miles) is groomed (conditions permitting) for cross-country skiing (skate and classic styles). No equipment rentals available.
- -Ungroomed, marked trails (19 miles) available for snowshoeing, hiking or equestrian use
- -Ice fishing
- -Portable toilets available
- -Archery deer hunting is permitted under MDNR rules at Addison Oaks-East, from Oct. 1-Jan.
- -Hunters must observe posted safety zones.

## **INDEPENDENCE OAKS**

- -Nearly 10 miles of groomed and marked trails
- -Ice Fishing
- -Cross-country skiing on all trails except Habitat trail
- -Hiking and snowshoeing are allowed on Habitat, River Loop and All-Visitor's trails (but no dogs orskiing on Habitat Trail)
- -Ice Skating, conditions permitting, on Crooked Lake
- -Volunteer Nordic Ski Patrol on duty as available and on weekends to assist skiers
- -Ski equipment rental available from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on weekends (weather permitting).
- -Group rentals are available weekdays by reservation only.
- -Warming areas and heated restrooms available. Skiers can also warm up at the nature center (closed Mondays).
- -Daily pass or Annual Vehicle Permit required and can be purchased at the park.

#### **HIGHLAND OAKS**

- -Hiking or equestrian use on 2.5 miles of trails
- -Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing for those with own equipment (not groomed)
- -Portable toilets available
- -No warming areas
- -Archery deer hunting is permitted under MDNR rules at Addison Oaks-East, from Oct. 1-Jan.
- -Hunters must observe posted safety zones.

## LYON OAKS

- -Hiking, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing (for those with own equipment) on nearly 6 milesof ungroomed trails.
- -Dog park offers off-leash recreation for dogs
- -On-leash dog walking is also allowed on the trails
- -Portable toilets available
- -Archery deer hunting is permitted under MDNR rules at Addison Oaks-East, from Oct. 1-Jan.
- -Hunters must observe posted safety zones.

#### **ORION OAKS**

- -Cross-country skiing, snowshoeing and hiking for those with own equipment (no grooming)
- -Ice fishing
- -Dog Park offers off-leash recreation for dogs
- -On-leash dog walking is also allowed on the trails.
- -Portable toilets available
- -No warming areas
- -Archery deer hunting is permitted under MDNR rules at Addison Oaks-East, from Oct. 1-Jan.
- -Hunters must observe posted safety zones.

## **RED OAKS**

- -Dog Park offers off-leash recreation for dogs
- -Enjoy 1.3 miles of novice paved trails for hiking at the Red Oaks Nature Center.

## **ROSE OAKS**

- -Cross-country skiing and snowshoeing for those with own equipment (no grooming)
- -Trails for hiking and equestrian use
- -Ice fishing
- -Portable toilets available
- -No warming areas
- -Archery deer hunting is permitted under MDNR rules at Addison Oaks-East, from Oct. 1-Jan.
- -Hunters must observe posted safety zones.

# WATERFORD OAKS

- -Hiking and snowshoeing on more than three miles of ungroomed trails
- -Family Sledding Hill
- -Portable toilets available
