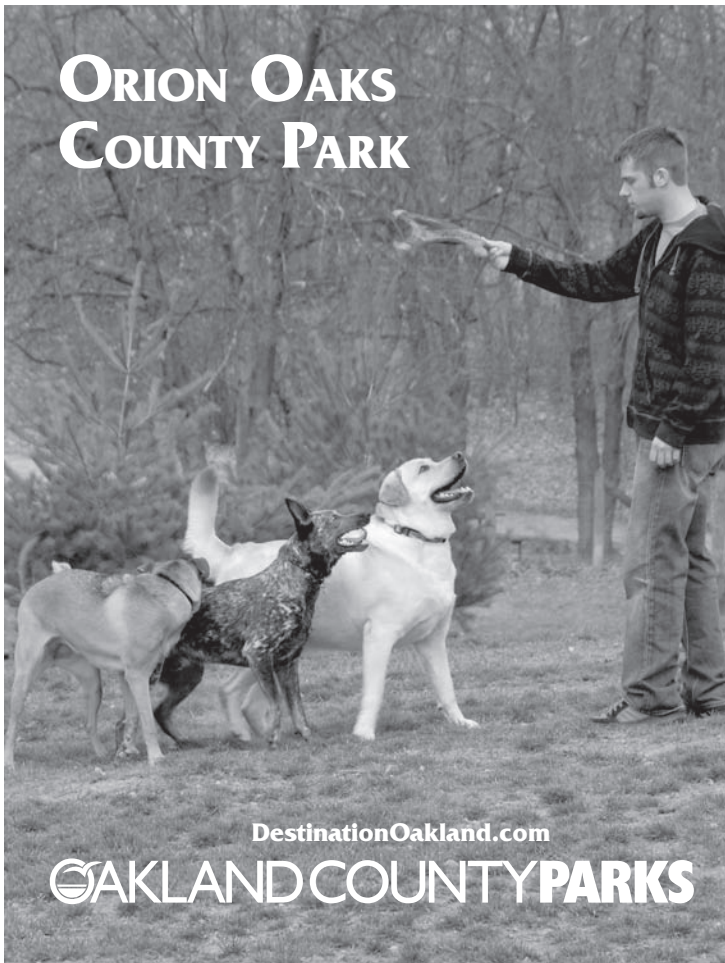

OAKLAND COUNTY PARKS

TRAIL RULES

1. Permitted uses include hiking, biking, geocaching, letterboxing and cross-country skiing (ungroomed). Fishing and non-motorized boating access also available.
2. Please stay on designated trails. Do not hike off trail or blaze new trails.
3. Trail hours: 1/2 hour before sunrise –1/2 hour after sunset, or as posted.
4. Leave no trace. Properly dispose of all garbage and pet waste in receptacles provided.
5. Collection, destruction, or taking of plants, wildlife, and natural surroundings is prohibited.
6. Dogs are permitted if confined on a leash not exceeding six feet in length. Off-leash dogs are allowed only in the dog park.
7. Help keep the Oakland County Parks safe, clean and well-maintained. Report accidents or vandalism to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office at 248.858.4950.
8. Report all injuries to parks staff at 248.625.0877.
9. In case of an emergency, dial 911 and give park location:

Annual Vehicle Permit Sales

Vehicles in designated parking lots must display a valid annual or daily Oakland County Parks motor vehicle pass. Citations will be issued.

Park in designated parking lots only—roadside parking around park perimeter is not permitted at any time.

Dog Park Information

**For the safety of all dogs and visitors,
please note:**

- Dog Park Hours:
8 a.m. to 1/2 hour after sunset.
- Dogs must be on a six-foot leash until inside enclosure.
- Maximum of two dogs per visitor.
- Dogs must have current license, up-to-date vaccinations, respond to voice command and be in visual control.
- No dogs under four months of age or in heat may enter the park.
- Dogs must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 or older) at all times, even inside the enclosure.
- Owners are responsible for pets at all times. Those creating problems will be asked to leave.
- No food allowed inside dog parks.
- Please clean up pet waste; bags supplied by **PET SUPPLIES "PLUS"**
- In compliance with Michigan Penal Code 750.66, all dog bites must be reported and information recorded. See park signage for details.
