Candidate Online Application Process

Step 1: Go to →

Step 2: Click on Job Title/Location

Step 3: Click APPLY NOW

Step 4: Click Preview steps for a preview summary

Step 5: Click Start Application

COLUMN B

A: Click Sign in / Create Account

B: Enter name, email address, phone number, time zone, and a personal pin.

C: Verify email address

The system will email a verification code to email address. This is a random code, different from your personal pin.

D: Verify phone number

The system will send a verification code via text message. This is a random code, different from your personal pin.

Application tips:

- Time Zone: Eastern Standard Time – America / New York.
- National ID (SSN with NO dashes)
- Do your best with the assessment! A low score will make you ineligible for 90 days.

Step 3: Accept Contingent Offer

Fill out the Non-Fair Credit Report Act Disclosure by providing two e-signatures and then clicking Next

Step 6: Personal Information

Application complete!

- If you exit application before completing, sign back in, click menu, home page, and click on **Jobs I've applied** and then **complete your application** to continue.

IMPORTANT:

- **Check your personal email for emails regarding your Drug test and Background check.**
- **Once Drug test and Background check are clear, and your shift is still available you will get an email from MyDocs and Knet.**
- **Your Knet videos and MyDocs paperwork MUST be completed prior to Day1.**
- **Please remember to bring a valid Photo ID with you on your first day.**

3. Is Amazon hiring?

If you don’t see jobs near you, sign up for mobile alerts by texting **AMAZON** to **77088**. If you’re only interested in driver roles, text **DRIVENOW** to **77088**.

You can also sign up for email alerts at amazon.com/tc.

Text "STOP" to opt-out.

4. Will this position be a full-time (Blue Badge) or a Seasonal position?

If SEASONAL your role can last up to 11 months based on business need. If the business has opportunities to convert to full time (blue badge) site leadership will notify you on how to apply.

5. Does Amazon offer benefits for hourly workers?

Amazon’s benefits can vary by location, the number of regularly scheduled hours you work, length of employment, and job status such as part-time, seasonal, or temporary employment. For more details, please visit <https://www.amazondeliverers.jobs/about/benefits/>

6. What are the requirements to work at Amazon?

You are 18 years or above

You have at least a high school diploma or equivalent

You are willing to submit to a pre-employment drug-test

7. Do I need to interview?

Our hiring process for most hourly roles does not include an interview!

If you are applying for delivery driver role, you will be required to interview as part of your hiring process.

8. Do I need a resume?

Most hourly jobs at Amazon do not require a resume, including warehouse, driver, and shopper jobs.

9. What happens after I complete the application?

You will need to schedule a new hire event.

10. What is a new hire event?

During the New hire event appointment, you will learn about your job, confirm your shift, take your badge photo and perform an oral drug test. In addition, you will bring in the proper valid documents to complete Section 2 on I9 See your email for a list of proper I9 documents or visit

<https://www.uscis.gov/i-9-central/acceptable-documents>

Note: Per the Federal Guidelines, Amazon cannot accept copies or expired documents

11. How long does it take for a Background Check/Drug Test results to come in?

Typically, Amazon can receive a drug test back within a week. The background check can vary depending on how many places one has lived, how many times their name has changed and any blemishes on their record.

*Reminder you cannot attend new hire orientation unless both drug test & background check have been cleared and the results are in the system. Both are outsourced to 3rd parties for your confidentiality. Our staffing team does not have access to your tests/cannot change results

12. What is Amazon pay rate?

\$15 an hour is the Amazon minimum wage—although you can make more based on your location and the shift you choose.

13. Does Amazon offer shift differentials?

Yes, Amazon offer shift differentials. It depends on the shift and the building. Remember- nights/weekends always pay more.

14. Will I be able to transfer to another shift, building or department?

Yes, If you are hired as a SEASONAL associate, you can transfer 30 days after you convert to a permanent employee. If Blue badge you can apply for a transfer after 30 days from orientation.

Note: transfers being based/available on business need
