



## A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Under the joint purview of the Oakland County Executive's Office and the Oakland County Workforce Development Division, Oakland80 sets an ambitious goal of having 80 percent of adults possess a post-high school degree or non-degree credential of value by 2030. This Request for Proposals (RFP) solicits responses from entities that seek to deliver Oakland80 Career and Education Navigation services throughout Oakland County. Oakland80 Career and Education Navigators will be responsible for providing career and education planning and navigation assistance to Oakland County residents. Oakland80 Career and Education Navigators will help individuals understand their skills, interests, and aptitudes and develop education and career plans to gain access to high quality, in demand jobs. Oakland80 Career and Education Navigators, working closely with partners, will also provide ongoing support to students enrolled in training to help ensure they stay on track to successfully complete their education, earning a postsecondary degree or credential.
