- Unemployed or underemployed
- U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen
- 18 years-old or older
- Not currently registered in school
- Selective Service registration, if applicable
- Background check
- Drug screen
- Immunizations
- Tuberculosis clearance (TB test)
